for the under-resourced at the Fresno City Council Meeting on February 23, 2023. They called themselves Young Leaders With A Voice and aptly stuck to the name as Victoria (center), James (right), and Joelle (next to Victoria) represented the student body. They took the bold step to address Councilman President Tyler Maxwell and his council members with a crowd from the community present as well as the online viewers looking on. They presented their research and call-to-action on issues regarding allocating resources towards homelessness, mental health, and suicide. After their speeches, council members responded to them and as Young Leaders With A Voice were leaving, other organizations stopped them on their way out the door to invite them to join their efforts., all the students were surprised by a spontaneous invitation by Mayor Jerry Dyer to come to his office. He addressed what he and his team are doing to combat the issues the students presented on. He also took time to encourage these young leaders to continue speaking up and speaking out for their concerns to other government entities.


A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:
